Our Theory of Change allows us to be more intentional with our mentoring relationships and solidify our impact with measurable outcomes. Young people graduate our programs with measurable outcomes in social emotional competence, mental health and well-being, educational engagement, and employment readiness.

In the past year, our agency alone has seen an unprecedented 200% increase in youth enrollment, highlighting the pressing need for mentorship. As we transition out of the pandemic, many young people are grappling with the effects of isolation and disrupted learning. Unfortunately, volunteer applications and funding have not kept pace with this surge in enrollment.

Our mentoring services rely on evidence-based approaches derived from the newest child development research. Additionally, our programs prioritize intentional and purposeful relationship building with youth. Mentoring is an intervention that re-maps brain architecture, a process which sets the child up for a lifetime of resilience, positive social interaction, and academic and career success.

BBBS PROGRAM SUPPORT

Each year, *Big Brothers Big Sisters* supports hundreds of young people who face adversity though mentoring programs that provide measurable outcomes. These outcomes are in areas like: relationship skills, social awareness, responsible decision making, mental wellness, school connectedness, commitment to learning, and much more. These programs are provided at NO COST to the families and are all supported by professional caseworkers. COMMUNITY BASED BIG BROTHER | BIG SISTER, COUPLES MATCH, FAMILY MATCH

Matching a young person one-on-one with a mentor, match couple or family. Spending time together on a weekly basis (2-4 hours) for a minimum of one year. Providing an opportunity for matches to see a positive and likely different dynamic than their family.

PRISM PROGRAM PRIDE | RESPECT | IDENTITY | SAFETY | MENTORING

Focusing on Oxford County's 2SLGBTQIA+ community, the program creates one-on-one mentoring and group relationships to build connections and combat feelings of isolation.

IN SCHOOL MENTORING SCHOOL BASED

Matching an elementary aged child with an adult mentor who meet during the school day on school property (or virtually).

LITERACY PROGRAM SITE BASED

This program is a group that provides children and youth in Grades 2-8 in elementary school with a friend and role model to assist students with their academic skills and self-esteem. Matches meet during the school year at their local library branch or agency office to improve their skills

GO GIRLS/GAME ON SITE BASED GROUP PROGRAMS

These programs are designed for young people between 11 and 14 years old. It focuses on healthy and active living as well as self-esteem and breaking down stereotypes.

SOAR (SOCIAL OPPORTUNITIES ACTIVITIES RELATIONSHIPS) GROUP WAITLIST FOCUSED

Designed to provide group mentoring experiences to those young people who are waiting for a one-on-one match. Groups take part in activities throughout the community, such as horseback riding, skating, photography, golf, movies, tours, etc.

VIRTUAL MATCHES WAITLIST FOCUSED

Developed during the pandemic, to reach and support young people who weren't already matched. Provides weekly connection 100% virtually..



EMPLOYERSUPPORTED VOLUNTEERING

An incredible way to support *Big Brothers Big Sisters* and the young people we serve is to start a volunteering incentive program at your business. You can provide them with an hour off during the week to mentor a child or provide other incentives to encourage your staff to volunteer on their own time.
